COURSE OUTLINE

Lesson 1 and 2: Methodology (9.00 - 11.15)

This session will focus on methods and skills required to teach grammar, vocabulary and phonology as well as receptive and productive skills. The class will also include two sets of peer observations in which participants can see teaching practice in action followed by discussion and analysis.

Lesson 3: Teaching Workshop (11.30 - 12.30)

The Workshops include practical and transferable activities that trainees can implement immediately into their lessons. Discussion of these and sharing of current practices will accompany this hands-on session.

Lesson 4 and 5: Language Focus (13.30 - 15.45)

Pitched at a proficiency level, these sessions are designed to enhance your own English language ability in the four skills as well as phonology and vocabulary.

COURSE EXTRAS

Plenary Sessions (8.45 - 9.00)

Our daily plenaries, during which our whole school gathers, mean you start each day with an inspirational presentation or activity. You will not only attend these but also lead one each week giving you the opportunity to share your experiences with the school and attempt new techniques you've learnt as well.

Extra Training (12.30 - 1.15 on Thursday)

You will also be invited to join our teaching team for one of our regular in-house training sessions which take place at lunchtimes on Thursday. You will discuss and learn about an aspect of teaching pedagogy with the Regent teachers as part of our team.

Practice Lesson (16.00 - 17.00 on Thursday)

You will have one hour each week after school to teach a group of students. You will plan a lesson as a group with your trainer and the other participants, deliver the lesson and receive constructive feedback on your techniques.
